This is very dangerous as they cannot control or tell who is observing them. Children have described making these videos in their bedrooms, placing them at risk. Please can we ask all parents and carers to be vigilant and check? Tik Tok is rated 12+ on the Apple app store and "teen maturity" on Google Play. However, there is no system in place to verify a user's age, so anyone can download it.
