Important Reminders

Reading Display

We are continuing to use the reading display, which displays a track for the

children to move along based on the number of pages they read. Please continue to remind your children to log all of their reading at home and make sure you have initialled/ signed your children's reading logs when they have read at home

to help them add these pages to their count and earn their reading rewards!

Pencil Cases

The children are allowed to bring in pencil cases to Owls Class. These could contain: pencil, rubber, glue stick, sharpener, black handwriting pen, blue pen, a small selection of coloured pencils. These should not contain: scissors, compass, permanent markers (e.g. sharpies). Children do not need small toys or lots of novelty rubbers in school.



Mobile Phones

If your child walks themselves to or from school and you would like them to have a mobile phone for this journey, please let us know and these can be dropped off to the office in the morning and collected at the end of the day.

The children are not allowed to keep mobile phones on them during the school day.
