Research - create a collage of newspaper articles you have found that show inspiring stories ~ this could be local, national or international stories.

Choose one activity (or create your own similar homework project) to bring to school at the end of the term ~ keep an eye on the school newsletter for the date of the homework assembly.

Writing - Write a short newspaper article focussing on either a natural disaster, an inspirational person or a spectacular event.

History - Make a timeline showing the significant time periods in the World's history.

PSHE - Who is an inspirational person to you? Choose someone you find inspirational and create a profile about them, explaining why you think they are inspirational.

Science - create a model of the solar system and make some information cards to accompany this.

Art - Draw or paint your own landscape picture.

Challenge: Can you find out about any famous landscape artists?

Create - Create a book about amazing things on our planet, this could include people achieving amazing things (such as inventors, record breakers, etc.) or amazing creatures that live on Earth.

Geography - draw a map of the World and label as many features of this as you can (for example, countries and their capitals, continents, oceans, tropics, etc.). This could be a lift the flap diagram.

Challenge: can you make a globe with information cards?

- Write a letter to someone who inspires you
