Our focus value for our Collective Worship this half term is peace & harmony and our Keeping Children Safe in School theme is Stay Alert and Stay Safe.

I am writing from the eerie silence of an empty school as we prepare for some of your children to return today. The staff, governors and I all hope that you have Stayed Safe and kept well so far through the COVID-19 pandemic. It has been a period of change, uncertainty and challenge. We have been open throughout the time, including the Easter holidays, caring for our children of the Key Workers. Teachers have worked hard in preparing home-school packs which we hope that you have found helpful. The work will continue to be set until mid-July. The teachers are also writing the Annual School Reports. These will reflect where the children were in mid-March. This week we welcome the Key Worker children (who will be based in the Badger classroom) alongside our EYFS, Y1 and Y6 children. Some parents and carers have chosen to send their children. The school looks and feels different: 2m lines; Individual standing spaces; desks not carpet; no collective worship or gatherings as a whole; staggered start, play, lunch and end times; but the staff are positive and prepared; We cannot provide water cups or fruit. Questions that we have been asked include Y6 – hoodies, transition to secondary school, leaving do…? Unknown, but not forgotten? Transition for new children and class teachers? Being discussed as a staff.
