School Driving and Parking Promise: To help improve pupil safety, by reducing the congestion on the roads outside the school and the impact this has on the local residents, we could all take this commitment:

I promise I will

1. Reduce my speed when I am in the roads near to the school.
2. Park away from the school entrance and walk the rest of the way to the school gate.
3. Not park on the double yellow lines or on the 'School Keep Clear' zigzags.
