The Governing Body at Barningham Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary School consists of members drawn from parents, carers, members of the community and school staff. We meet as a whole governing body once a term and various governors are members of other committees, depending on their skills and experience. For example, the finance committee monitors the school's budget and makes sure our money is well spent for the benefit of the children. The personnel committee deals with staffing issues such as recruitment. The premises committee looks after the building and was involved in planning the recently built Year 5/6 classroom.

We visit the school on a regular basis, acting as "critical friends". We have areas to monitor, such as literacy or numeracy and we also help to monitor the School Development Plan. Other responsibilities include safeguarding and special educational needs.

Our role is to support and challenge the school so that every child is given the opportunity to achieve his/her full potential.

The total number of governors is eleven, but we also have one associate governor.
