Reception Places September 2025-2026

If your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021, you must apply for a full-time Reception Year school place by 15 January 2025. Even if your child attends our Nursery, parents still need to apply separately for a Reception place ready for September 2025 start. Parents must make an application even if your child already has a place in a nursery class, pre-school or family hub.
