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Reception Places September 2025-2026

If your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021, **you must apply for a fulltime Reception Year school place by 15 January 2025**. Even if your child attends our Nursery, parents still need to apply separately for a Reception place ready for September 2025 start. Parents **must** make an application even if your child already has a place in a nursery class, pre-school or family hub.
